Brown Jr., is responsible for helping the Governor build his administration by recruiting top candidates to serve the state. She is the first Filipino-American in California history to serve as the Appointments Secretary. Prior to her appointment, Mona served as Chief of Staff to California Lieutenant Governor John Garamendi and as Acting Lieutenant Governor. This marked the first time a woman, Asian Pacific Islander or Filipino-American served as Lieutenant Governor of California.
